- •The first major research project was to 'analyze the impact of COVID-19 on the tourism and cultural industries in Sichuan Province and consider the potential for new projects to mitigate this impact, such as night tourism, cultural parks, film and television industries, etc.'. By using Excel and Google Analytics, the data related to the construction of national parks, intangible cultural heritage, 5A scenic spots, and other projects in each region of the province in the past five years were classified and summarised; by using mathematical formulae and application software, the density of these natural resources was calculated and bar charts, flow charts and mind maps were created; by comparing the number of tourism resources in other Chinese provinces and cities By comparing the difference in density between the number of tourism resources in other provinces and cities in China and the number of tourism resources in Sichuan, I was able to analyze the impact of the New Coronary Pneumonia epidemic on the tourism and cultural industry in Sichuan in an integrated and comprehensive manner. I gained a comprehensive understanding of the map of natural resources in Sichuan province and established a link between resource management and policy direction in my knowledge system;
- •The second major research project is 'Promoting China's 14th Five-Year Plan through the creation of cultural and tourism villages. Data on representative villages selected across the country were collected, statistical tables were produced, and various data analysis charts were generated to provide background and data to support the construction of scenic projects in the 14th Five Year Plan of Sichuan Province. For example, statistics and classifications of China's well-known distinctive cultural and tourism villages, analysis of the value of the more than 500 villages selected by the national Ministry of Culture and Tourism, and distillation of village business models that can have the potential for success in the Sichuan region. The aim of these activities is to ensure that the Ministry of Culture and Tourism of Sichuan Province selects the "Famous Villages and Towns of Tianfu Tourism", "Famous Products of Tianfu Tourism" and "Famous Tourism Professionals/Guides of Tianfu Tourism". to promote the development of rural areas in Sichuan Province;
- •The third independent research project was a study on the development of the tourism industry in China. I searched many statistical websites and statistical yearbooks to collect the value added of the cultural industry in each province within China from 2004 to 2019, and then calculated the combined data. When data was missing for some provinces, I contacted the statistical bureau or data department of the province to ask for and complete the data collection and collation, which also helped my independent research and communication skills.
